LEGO SOCIAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT GROUP

Does your child love Lego? Do they have trouble making friends? Openings are now available for children ages 8-13 years in Lego Club. We accept children with ADHD, Asperger's, Anxiety, Learning Disabilities, Selective Mutism, and other disabilities.

This is a **therapy group** so all children are **screened** to make sure they are a **good fit**. The groups are facilitated by the **only certified Lego Social Skills Therapy Coach in Saskatchewan**. Cass Phillips, MA, PhD has been offering these groups in Saskatoon for over a decade.



Children with Asperger's, ADD, and LD often lag behind their peers when it comes to social skills that are essential to success in school and in life. Using ABA (Applied Behaviour Analysis) principles and the child's love of Lego, the group

- Gives the child a sense of belonging
- Focuses on social communication skills such as waiting, sharing, turn taking, letting go of control, collaborating, negotiating, and perspective-taking
- Demonstrates behavioural change in the child that can be carried outside of group (e.g., home, school, and community)
- Provides opportunities for the child to develop healthy peer relationships

Cost: \$335.00 for total of one hour, once per week, for 10 consecutive weeks, plus written group overview as feedback. Receipts available for insurance, and government funding.
