Does your child love Lego and doing crafts? Does he/she need to spend more time learning to play with other children?

Openings are now available for children ages 5-7 years in our Little Creators Group. We accept children with ADHD, Asperger's, Separation Anxiety, Learning Disabilities, Selective Mutism and other disabilities who have social challenges.

This is a **therapy group** so all children are **screened to make sure they are a good fit**. The groups are facilitated by the **only certified Lego Social Skills Therapy Coach in Saskatchewan. CassPhillips, BA, MA, PhD** has been offering these groups in Saskatoon for over a decade.

Taking the child's developmental age and cognitive skills set into consideration, the group uses ABA (Applied Behaviour Analysis) principles to facilitate learning in areas such as communication, waiting, sharing, turn taking and letting go of control. We also build cognitive, fine motor and emotional skills. The group aims

- To give the child a sense of belonging
- To create an environment that allows for social skills development
- To demonstrate behavioural change in the child that is sustainable over the long term
- To lay the foundation for healthy peer relationships
